

One-Day Forum on

Global Supply Chain Strategy in India

Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) is organizing a one-day Forum at IIM Bangalore on "Global Supply Chain Strategy in India: Outsourcing, Re-shoring and Near-shoring" in collaboration with The Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania, USA and Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), USA.

The Forum, scheduled for Saturday, November 23, 2013 will comprise of Keynote Talks by leaders from Industry and Academia followed by a Panel Discussion in which well known names from Indian Industry and academics from Wharton and IIMB will participate. The following is a brief overview of the motivation and objectives of the forum.

For decades a dominant strategy in manufacturing has been to outsource to low cost global suppliers. This has led to the transfer of jobs and development activities out of the US, Japan and Europe and into low labor cost countries such as China, India and Vietnam. In view of the fundamental change to the environment in which global supply chains operate there is a trend in many firms to "re-shore" their manufacturing by bringing it back or at least moving it closer to their developed country market, i.e. by "near-shoring".

This forum will provide participants with the opportunity to explore current thinking and practices concerning global supply chain strategy and sourcing from the perspective of both Indian and non-Indian companies. Forum interactions will facilitate exchange of ideas on current practices and intentions of participating companies.
